My name is Bret Busby, and I have lived in at my current address in the ward, for 16 years (as at September 2009). I am the only candidate for this ward, in this election, who lives in this ward.

I live in the Gwynne Park/Brookdale part of the ward. We have not had a councillor who lives in this part of the ward, representing this part of the ward, for several years. If I am elected as a councillor for this ward, I will be the first councillor living in this area, representing this area in the city council, for several years.

Eight feet wide concrete paths along all roads in the built up areas, so that pedestrians, gophers, wheelchairs and people pushing prams, can travel safely and not be made to travel on the roads, adequate road shoulders on rural roads, fixed rubbish bins at all parks and reserves and at all bus stops, properly maintained street trees that are pruned back from the roads and that do not obstruct visibility for vehicle drivers on the roads, and adequate street lighting, are just some of the changes that I want implemented, to make the area safer and healthier.

Whether you vote for me, or against me, **PLEASE VOTE**. We do not have enough say in what goes on, but, we can decide who gets elected to the council, so we should at least use that. This ward had the lowest voter turnout in the state, at the 2005 local government elections. Less than a third of eligible voters in Armadale, overall, lodged valid votes, in the 2007 election. **If you live in this ward, and are eligible to vote in the 2009 Armadale City Council election, in the Lake Ward, you should vote,** as you are responsible for the election outcome. Over the years, I have tried to improve conditions for the people who live in Armadale and the people who work in Armadale. Please read the candidate profiles when you receive the voting papers, and consider them, and, **PLEASE VOTE**.

I live in the Lake Ward in Armadale, and have lived in the area covered by the Lake Ward of Armadale, for over sixteen years, and I regularly walk along local streets, so I see what is happening in the area.

Voting in this election is first past the post. So, if you want to vote for me, mark the box beside my name, and, if you want to vote against me, do the same, but for the other candidate.
